Mathias Arnold is the current Vice-President of the Federal Union of German Associations of Pharmacists, ABDA. He holds a degree in pharmaceutical studies from the University of Halle and has been certified as pharmacist since 1988. Until today, Mr Arnold owns the Lilien-Apotheke in Halle.

In 1999, he joined the Chamber Assembly at the Sachsen-Anhalt Chamber of Pharmacists and was elected as Chairman in 2005. Since 2013, Mr Arnold is the current Vice-President of the Federal Union of German Associations of Pharmacists and since 2020 the Vice-President of the Pharmaceutical Group of European Union (PGEU).
